ARTIST INFORMATION

FESTIVAL DATES AND TIMES

The 2008 Madisonville Wooden Boat Festival is planned for Saturday, October 18, and Sunday, October 19, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily.

LOCATION

The festival is held in the Town of Madisonville, Louisiana, along the Tchefuncte River on South Water Street, at the Madisonville Ball Park, and at the Lake Pontchartrain Basin Maritime Museum.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The deadline for applications is September 1, 2008. There is a nonrefundable \$50 application fee for applications received after September 1, 2008. No applications will be considered after September 30, 2008. Applications received without payment or photos, etc., cannot be considered.

SELECTION PROCESS

An independent anonymous jury committee will review the applications. Criteria for selection include creativity, quality, and originality, distinctions for which the committee will rely on the applicant's complete description and photographs of the work. Preference will be given to maritime- and Louisiana-themed work. Artists will be notified of acceptance by mail.

BOOTH SPACE

A 10' x 10' booth space ONLY is provided. Booth space cannot be shared or sublet. Exhibitors must furnish their own tents, signage, tables, chairs, electrical cords, etc. Tents must be freestanding, 10' x 10', with or without sides. For safety reasons, tie-down lines cannot extend past your space. Consideration will be given to requests for specific sites, but assignments are at the discretion of the MWBF.

FEES

The charge for a booth space is \$300 if application is received by August 1, 2008. After that date the fee is \$350. Applications received after September 1 deadline incur the application fee as well. Booth fee must be paid in full before the application will be considered. The booth fee is returned if the application is not accepted. The booth fee is nonrefundable once the application is accepted. Electricity is available during festival hours for an additional charge. See fee schedule. Distance to the nearest outlet may exceed 100 ft. Vendors must provide their own extension cord(s). Vendors cannot share electricity. No generators can be used on festival grounds.

VENDOR CHECK-IN

All vendors must check in and pick up registration packets on Friday, October 17, between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. at Madisonville Town Hall on South Water Street. Each artist will receive two (2) artist badges. Booths must be set up on Friday during check-in times or on Saturday before 7 a.m. Vehicles must be removed from festival grounds before the streets close at 8 a.m. on Saturday. Vendor parking during the festival will be available at the museum on Mabel Drive. A vendor shuttle will be available. No vehicles may be left unattended. No vehicles are allowed on site after 7 a.m.

TAXES

Vendors are responsible for reporting their own taxes. Sales taxes must be paid to St. Tammany Parish (4.75%) and the State of Louisiana (4%).

MARITIME MUSEUM

Vendors are invited to visit the Lake Pontchartrain Basin Maritime Museum during the festival weekend. Admission to the museum is free during the festival with vendor badge or festival admission.

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ARTIST RULES & REGULATIONS

- Only original work will be accepted. Commercially manufactured items are strictly prohibited.
- The MWBF reserves the right to reject an application for any reason, including not meeting proper qualifications for festival participation. Refunds of payment will be made only to applicants not accepted for participation.
- Applications will be juried on a first-come, first-served basis and booth spaces will be assigned upon approval from the jury. All applicants not accepted by the jury committee will receive a full refund.
- Artists with trailers must include detailed photographs and dimensions of trailer with application.
- Artists must pick up check-in packets at Vendor Check-In in Town Hall prior to setting up.
- Each artist will be given two (2) artist badges in the check-in packet that will serve as admission to the festival through the weekend. Additional passes can be purchased at half price (\$5 each) only at the time of check-in.
- No vehicles are allowed on site after 7 a.m. Streets will be closed to traffic at 8 a.m. Saturday.
- No pets are allowed on festival grounds.
- Artists can only sell the items that were approved on the application.
- MWBF reserves the right to make changes to the site layout at any time.
- Artists are not allowed to place merchandise, tables, ice chests, chairs, etc., beyond their designated booth space.
- Artists must provide plastic bags to collect booth trash and carry it to bins provided by the MWBF.
- Booths must remain open and intact for the duration of the festival.
- Artists must be present on site during the entire festival. Other representatives will not be permitted to substitute for the artist unless prior permission is given.
- Sales taxes are the responsibility of the vendor. Vendors must report sales and pay sales taxes to the State of Louisiana and to St. Tammany Parish.
